

What's so great about Libby?

- You can read or listen to items right in the Libby app
- You can download items for offline enjoyment, or stream them to save space
- You can sign into multiple libraries, with one or more cards for each library
- You can highlight or annotate your text
- You can adjust the playback speed when listening to audiobooks
- You can tag titles to organize the books you've read, want to read, loved, or hated
- You can sample any book with one tap to help you decide if you want to borrow the book
- You can change your reading settings to enlarge your font, switch to an OpenDyslexic font, or change your lighting mode to sepia or dark
- You can see a progress bar to know how many pages you have left in a chapter or book
- You can find out the approximate wait time on a title to help determine whether or not to place something else on hold, or to borrow another title while you wait

FAQs:

Do I need an internet connection?

Only to browse the catalog and to download

What happens when a title expires?

The titles will automatically return themselves, no action is needed on your part

What if I don't finish my book?

The app will remember your place, simply check out the title again to resume reading. Your *Settings* controls how many past titles are remembered

Can I renew a book?

Yes! If there are no holds on the title, you can renew two days before it is due. Simply tap on the cover for your details, and tap Renew Loan, then Renew!

Can I return an eBook early?

Yes! Tap the cover, then Return Title to Library, and confirm by tapping Return!


Getting Started with Libby





1. Install App

- Search for the free *Libby* app in your device's app store and install



- On first run, scroll through the welcome to “Search For a Library” or “Guess My Library.” You can either search for your library or allow the app to use your current location to find the nearest library.
- Select the SAILS Library Network and the Hanson Public Library



- Choose what platform you intend to primarily use, Kindle or Libby (this can always be changed later)
- Enter your library card number and pin, and you are ready to listen or read!

2. Explore

- Libby has two areas, Library and Shelf. Library lets you explore titles to check out, and Shelf shows you everything you have checked out or on hold!




- Scroll through the homepage for curated collections like recently added titles or holiday books
- Search for a specific title you wish to borrow at the top of your screen: you can search by author, title, or keyword and apply filters for a specific format or items available now
- Tap on a book cover to learn more, and tap Borrow to check out a title. If a title is unavailable you can always Place a Hold. Not sure you want the book? Read a sample!
- After you've borrowed a book, tap Open Book to enjoy your book
- From your Shelf, you can renew items if you need more time or return items if you're done early

3. Tips & Tricks

- All ebooks and audio books in this collection can be found through our main catalog! So if you're searching for a title though sails.ent.sirsi.net keep an eye out for “ebook” and “e-audio”
- You can use the Preferences bar to modify your default search and display settings. You can modify even more setting , like your Download Behavior, from the Libby icon in the top right corner



- When browsing for items, Audiobooks will display a set of headphones on their book cover
- Item not available? Tap the ... next to Place Hold to find information about the wait list



- You can check out 6 items at time and place up to 10 holds at a time
