Read the book and watch the movie, then join us for a lively discussion and some light refreshments.



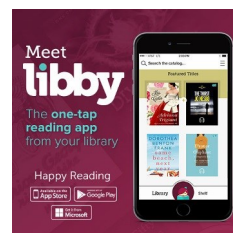

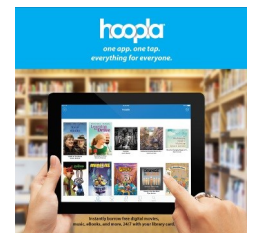

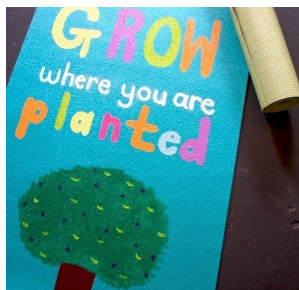
Paint an abstract design and turn it into a guitar. Limit 20.

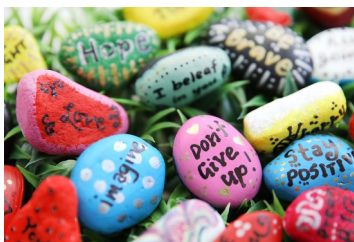

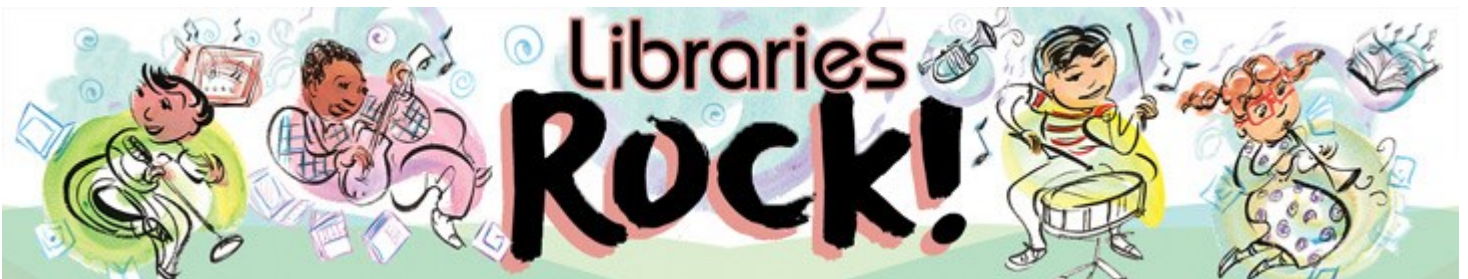
