

How to Reserve Your Pass Online

- Visit our website at hansonlibrary.org and look for Services -> Adventure Passes
- Choose a date and pass, and click "Request Pass." Enter your library card number and PIN.
- Some passes are digital and will be sent via email or SMS. Other passes must be picked up at the Library.
- Passes may be picked up at the Library up to two days before your reservation date.
- Passes that need to be returned to the Library may be put in the book drop if the Library is not open.
- **Please note:** Some museums and attractions require timed entry tickets/reservations in addition to your library pass. Please be sure to read all instructions when you reserve a pass. While we make every effort to stay updated with venue hours, closings, and prices, we advise that you check the venue's website before you visit.
