How It Works

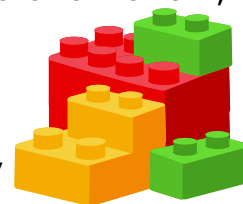
1. Visit the circulation desk at the library to pick up a "Plant a Seed, Read" reading tracker, or print one from the Summer Reading page on the library's website.
2. Tell us how many minutes you read each week to enter our weekly raffle drawings. Color in a picture for every 15 minutes you spend reading.
3. When you color in a full page, turn it in at the library to add a piece to our "Community Garden" board, and you'll be entered in that week's prize drawing.

Winners will be drawn weekly for experiential prizes. You do not need to be present to win. Winners will be notified by phone or email. At the end of the challenge period, all children who tracked their reading will receive a coupon for a free ice cream scoop from Heidi's Hollow, courtesy of the Hanson Public Library Foundation.
