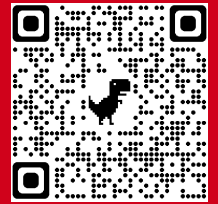


Hanson Public Library Internship

INTERNSHIP PROGRAM

Is there something you're passionate about that you'd like to share with the Hanson community? Is there a program or service you think the Library should offer? Apply to the Hanson Public Library Internship Program! Working independently and with Library staff, interns are invited to develop a project designed to improve the Library through building the collection, creating reading lists/displays, organizing a program/event, and more. Examples of projects include highlighting banned books, celebrating April is Poetry Month, promoting a social justice initiative, running a social media campaign, or creating a new gaming collection.

Internship projects are designed to be 10-20 hours over the course of 1-3 months. Internships are an unpaid volunteer experience. Program benefits include the opportunity to learn about libraries, gain and enhance critical skills, fulfill community service requirements, build a competitive resume, and develop references for college applications and future employment.
